According to the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG), all women ages 21 years and older need to have Pap smear screenings. The primary purpose of the Pap smear is to identify patients who have cellular changes that place them at risk for the development of cervical

cancer. Because the Pap smear is a screening tool, further evaluation may be required when abnormalities occur.

Program faculty will discuss how to obtain a Pap smear, the rationale for current treatment, and how to counsel and refer women with abnormal results.
