The Alabama Department of Public Health will provide care coordination services for 512 children throughout the entire state through selected Head Start Centers and Family Day Care Homes. Care coordination services can be provided for up to 566 Head Start children and the Alabama Department of Public Health may receive more referrals. Head Start Centers and Family Day Care Homes serve children from six weeks through four years. This means that a child will receive care coordination services throughout the entire time he/she attends Head Start. Program faculty will discuss the care coordination services for children referred through the DHR Early Head Start grant.

The focus of these services will address the assessment of medical services, education medical compliance, linkage to community resources, as well as, the billing process specific to this grant program.
