

ABCCEDP ELIGIBILITY UPDATE

Effective Date: July 1, 2016

To: ABCCEDP Providers



FREE BREAST CANCER SCREENING

- Women age 40 – 64
- Women under age 40 (Very high breast cancer risk only)
 - Personal history of breast cancer, **OR**
 - Breast mass **AND** one of the following:
 - 1st degree relative with breast cancer (mother, sister, father)
 - Bloody nipple discharge expressed by medical provider during CBE
- Women who meet income eligibility
- Women who have no insurance or are underinsured

FREE CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING

- Women age 40 – 64
- Women age 30 – 39 who have had tubal ligation
- Women age 30-39
 - Cervical diagnostic follow-up services only for women in the Family Planning program who have abnormal cervical cancer screening results
- Women who meet income eligibility
- Women who have no insurance or are underinsured

INCOME ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

(Effective February 1, 2016, until revised)

Household Size	Annual Income	Monthly Income
1	\$23,760	\$1,980
2	\$32,040	\$2,670
3	\$40,320	\$3,360
4	\$48,600	\$4,050
5	\$56,880	\$4,750
6	\$65,160	\$5,430

Add \$8,280 annually or \$690 monthly for each additional household member
