FREE BREAST CANCER SCREENING

- Women age 40 64
- Women under age 40 (Very high breast cancer risk only)
 - o Personal history of breast cancer, OR
 - Breast mass <u>AND</u> one of the following:
 - 1st degree relative with breast cancer (mother, sister, father)
 - Bloody nipple discharge expressed by medical provider during CBE
- Women who meet income eligibility
- Women who have no insurance or are underinsured

FREE CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING

- Women age 40 64
- Women age 30 39 who have had tubal ligation
- Women age 30-39
 - o Cervical diagnostic follow-up services only for women in the Family Planning program who have abnormal cervical cancer screening results
- Women who meet income eligibility
- Women who have no insurance or are underinsured
