

EMSP LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS

Licensure Requirements for EMT, Advanced EMT, Intermediate EMT, and Paramedic

- Application
- Criminal History Form (Initial Application Only)
- Copy of National Registry card if you have ever been Nationally Registered
- If you have never been Nationally Registered you must submit the same continuing education that is required by the National Registry to the OEMS.
- Current Alabama Protocols (certificate on website)
- License Fee two year license - \$12.00

Reciprocity Information:

- You must be Nationally Registered to apply for an Alabama EMSP license.
- Alabama does not issue **INITIAL** Intermediates EMT licenses. If you are a Nationally Registered Intermediate EMT, you are eligible for licensure at the EMT level.

Renewal Period:

- The OEMS will start accepting RENEWAL applications January 2nd of each year.

Ambulance Drivers:

- Drivers must maintain current EVOC certification and keep on file at the service you are working with.
