HOME HEALTH

The Home Care Program uses a holistic approach to provide home health services prescribed by a physician. Services are delivered to qualified homebound Medicare patients, Medicaid, or commercial insurance recipients.

Services Provided May Include

- Skilled Nursing
- Home Health Aide
- Medical Social Services
- Physical Therapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Speech Pathology services

Medical Criteria

- Medical need requiring home services
- Homebound
- Physician's order

Financial Criteria

There are home health benefits under the Medicare and Medicaid programs. Most private insurance policies will also pay for home health care.

LIFE CARE

The Home Care Program provides Life Care services to clients who are elderly, frail, injured, or disabled and assists them in maintaining their quality of life. Clients do not have to be homebound to receive Life Care services.

However, clients who receive these services must meet certain eligibility requirements or may purchase services on a sliding fee scale.

ELDERLY AND DISABLED/ HIV AIDS WAIVER PROGRAM

These programs provide an alternative to nursing home placement for any individuals in Alabama who are aged, have a disability, or diagnosed with HIV. The Elderly and Disabled/HIV AIDS Waiver Programs are funded through Medicaid.

- Personal Care
- Respite Care
- Companion Services
- Skilled Nursing
- Case Management Services
- Home Delivered Meals
- Adult Day Health
