AGENCY HISTORY

Aletheia House is a community-based not for profit organization that has been providing substance abuse treatment and prevention services to individuals and the communities in which they live since 1972. It is one of Alabama's largest providers of substance abuse treatment, prevention, employment and affordable housing services.

The organization was founded to address the needs of teens who were living on the streets in Birmingham, Alabama. The founders named the organization Aletheia because it means "truth" or "to be truthful with yourself".

The agency's current Executive Director, Chris Retan, was hired in 1978. The Chief Operating Officer Gloria Howard joined the organization in 1991.

In 2012, Aletheia House was named the 9th largest non profit in the Birmingham area by the Birmingham Business Journal.

The agency has received national and regional recognition for its programs, including the:
