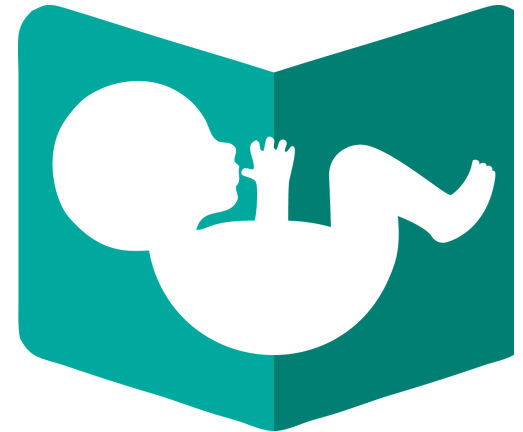

5. It is highly recommended that you observe a full Lamaze childbirth education series.
6. It is highly recommended that an LCCE observe the first series that you teach.
7. It is recommended that you review the BOLTs (Brief Online Learning Tutorials) at <http://uthsc.edu/listen/bolts.php>

All participants are expected to be familiar with the anatomy and physiology of pregnancy, birth, and postpartum; medical terms, common procedures and tests during normal pregnancy, birth, and postpartum; and normal newborn appearance and procedures, along with the basics of breastfeeding.
